AWARD: VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

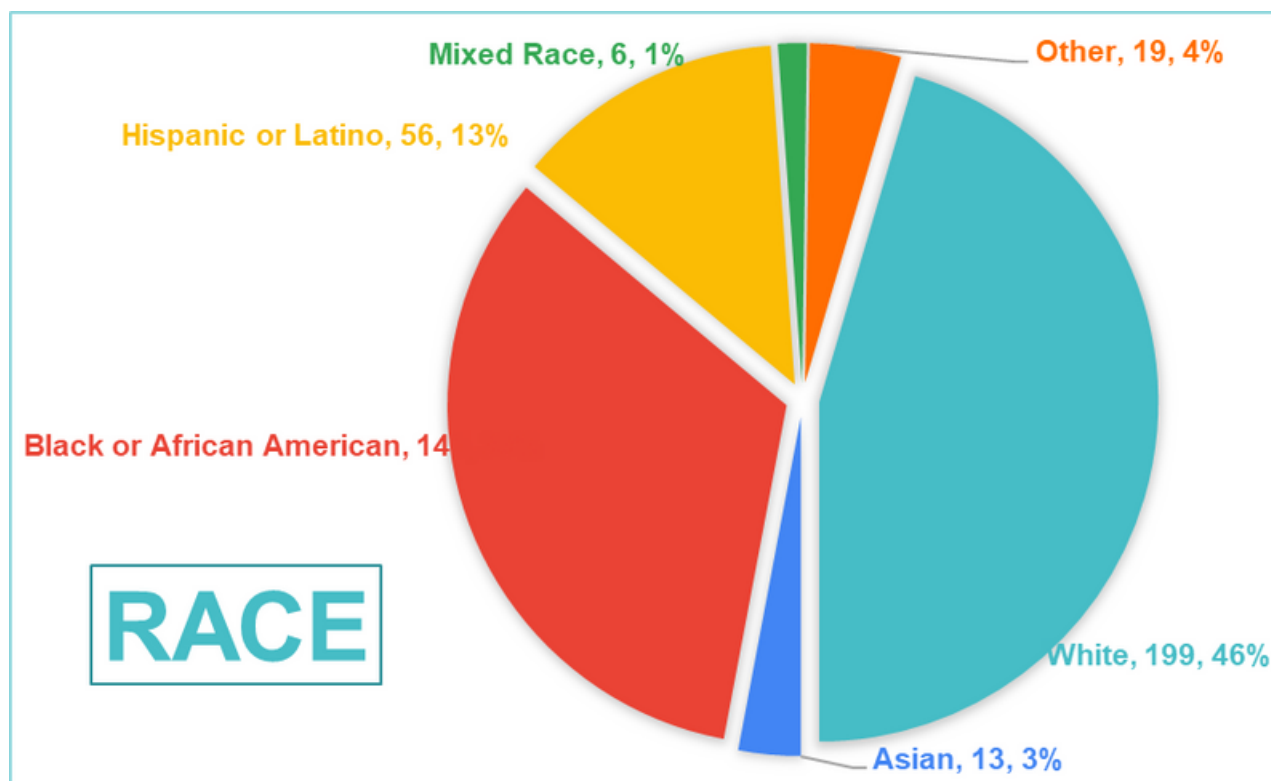
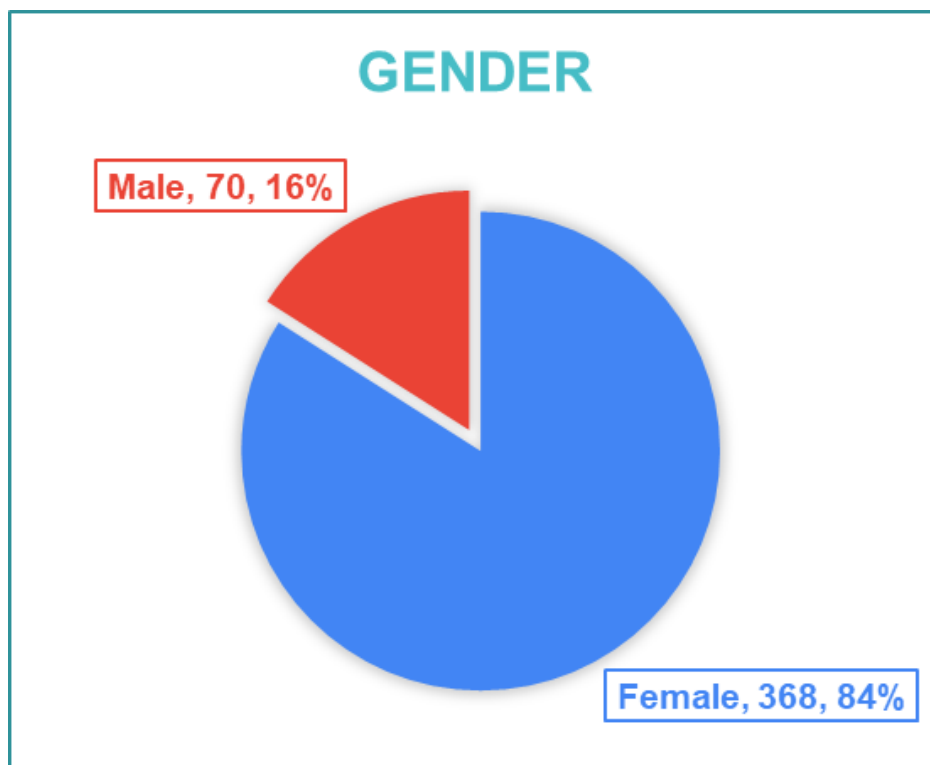

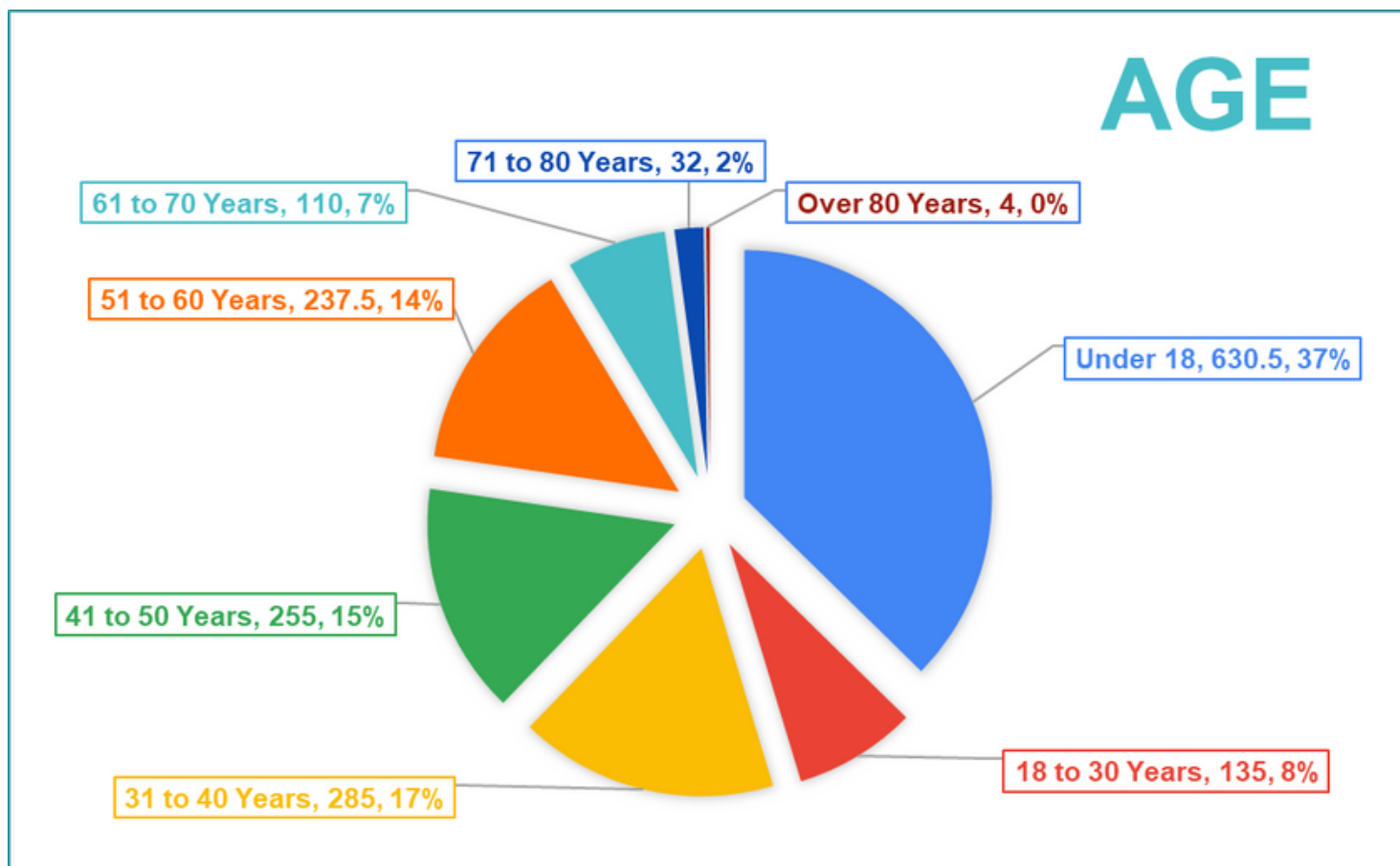


Gender & Race of the People We Serve

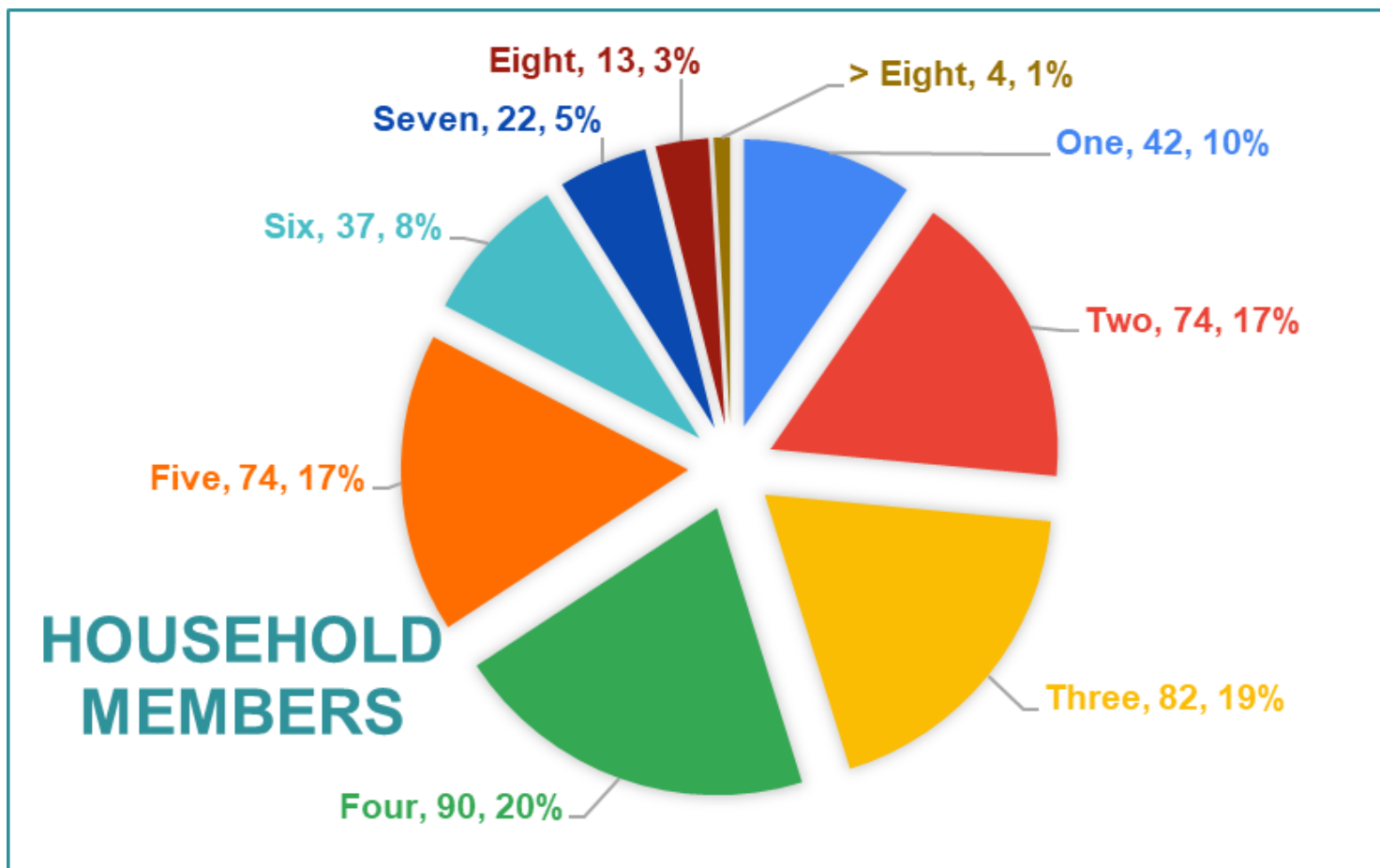
Age Group of the People We Serve

Household Members



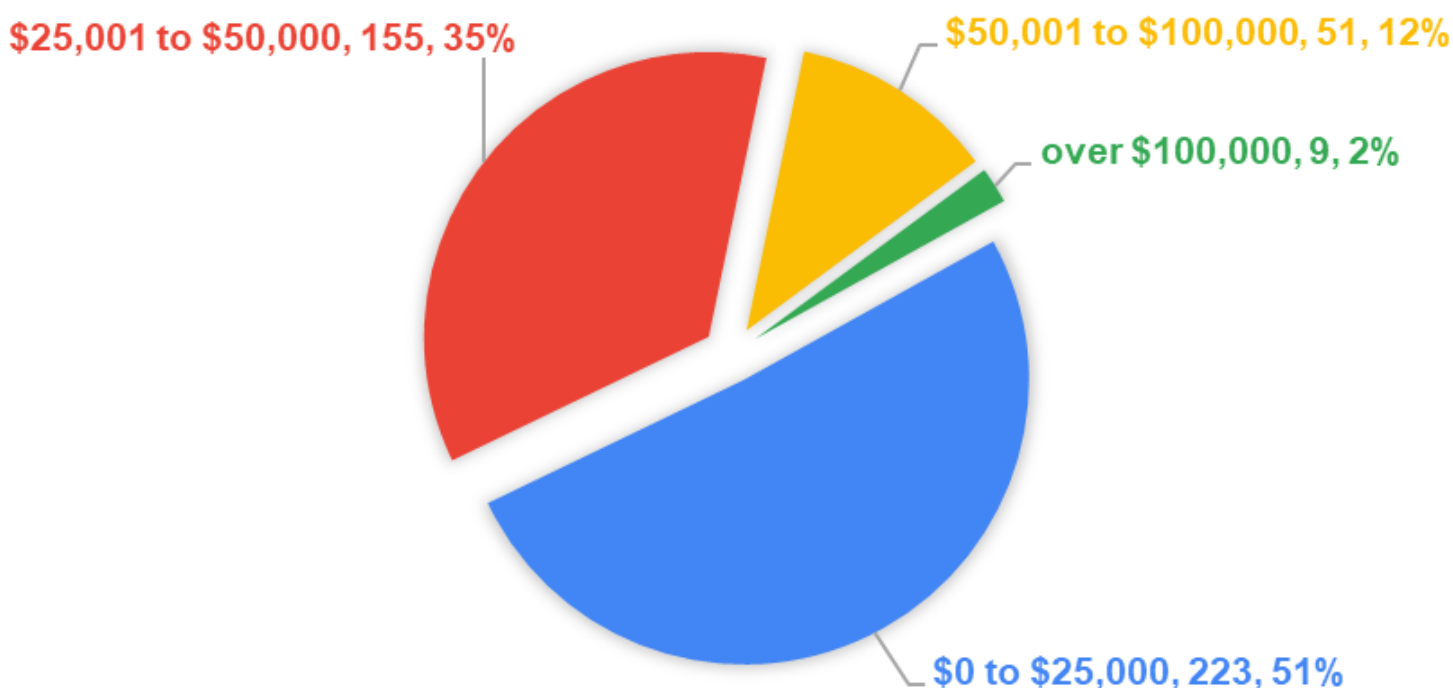

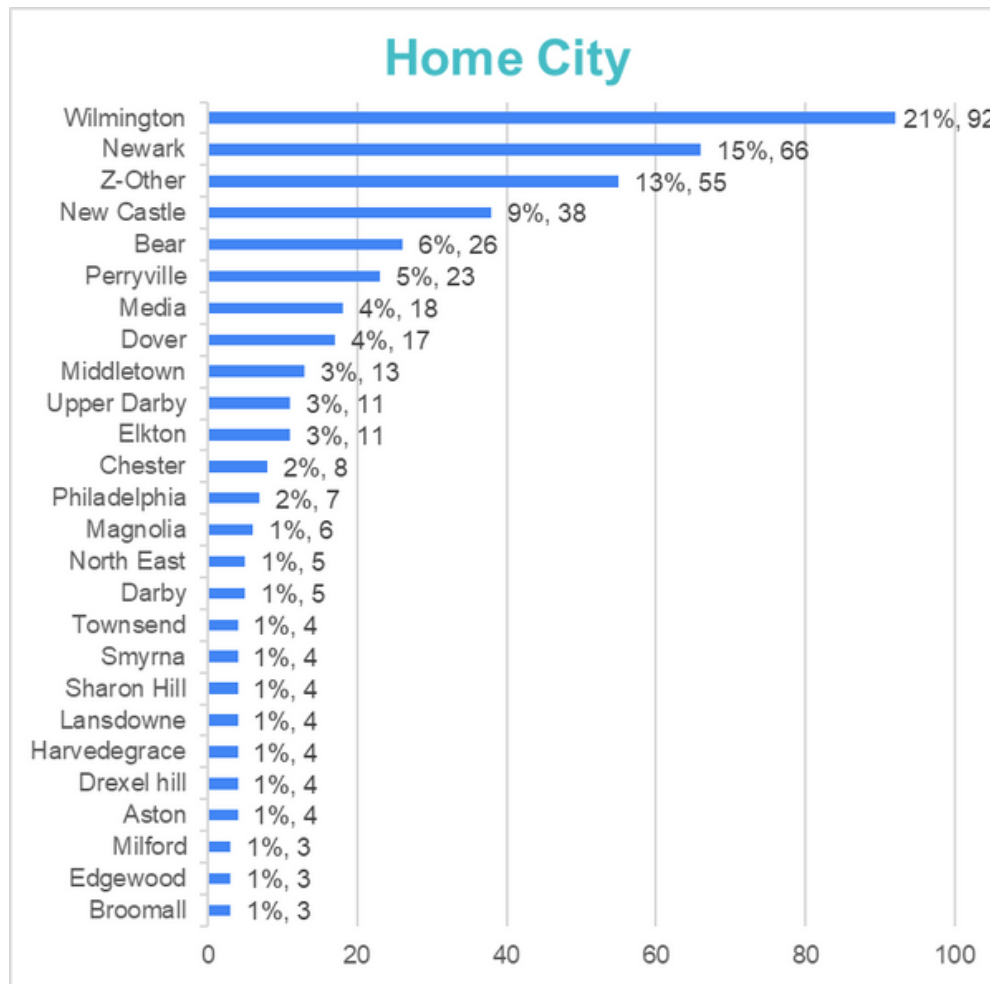
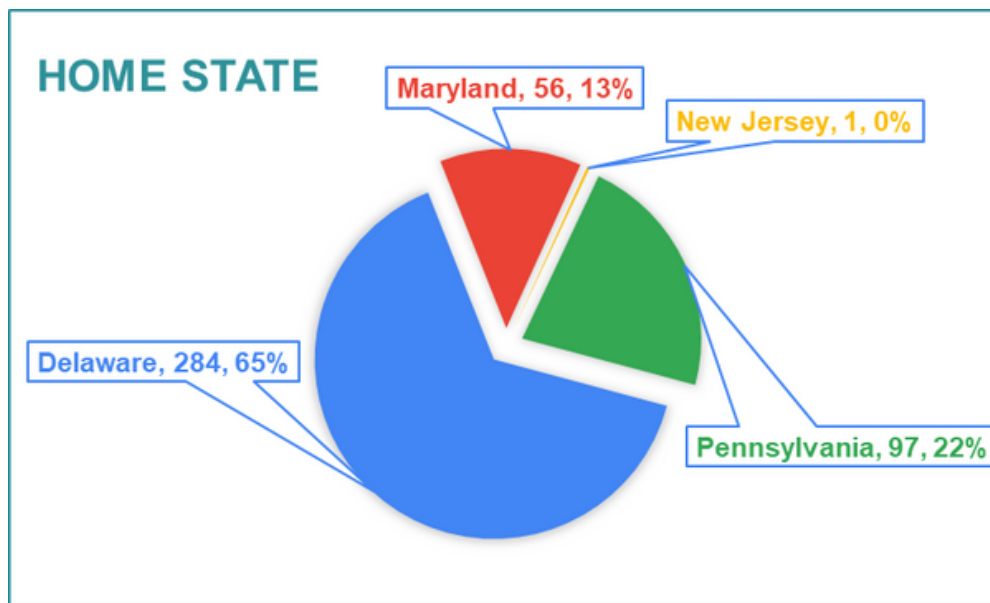

State & City of the People We Serve

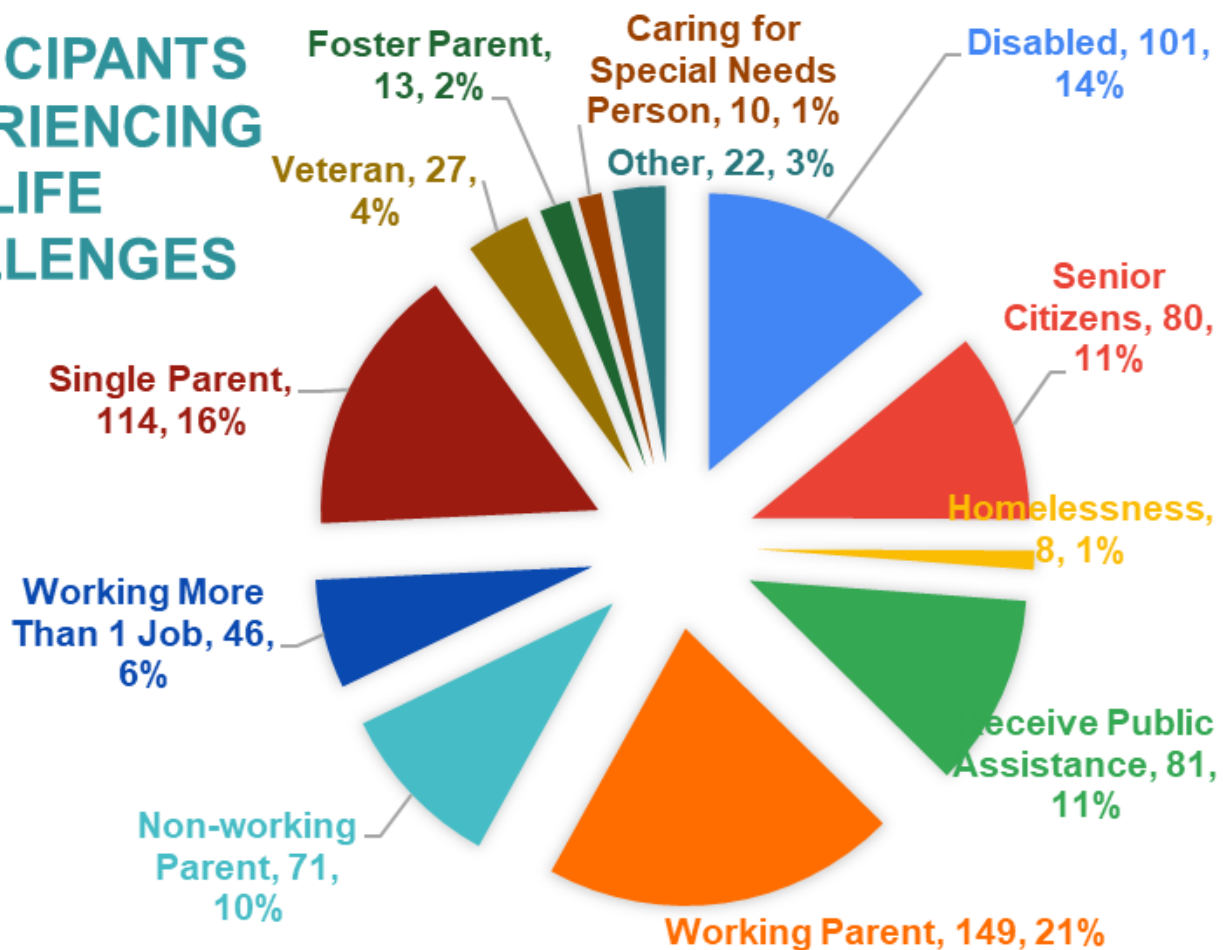

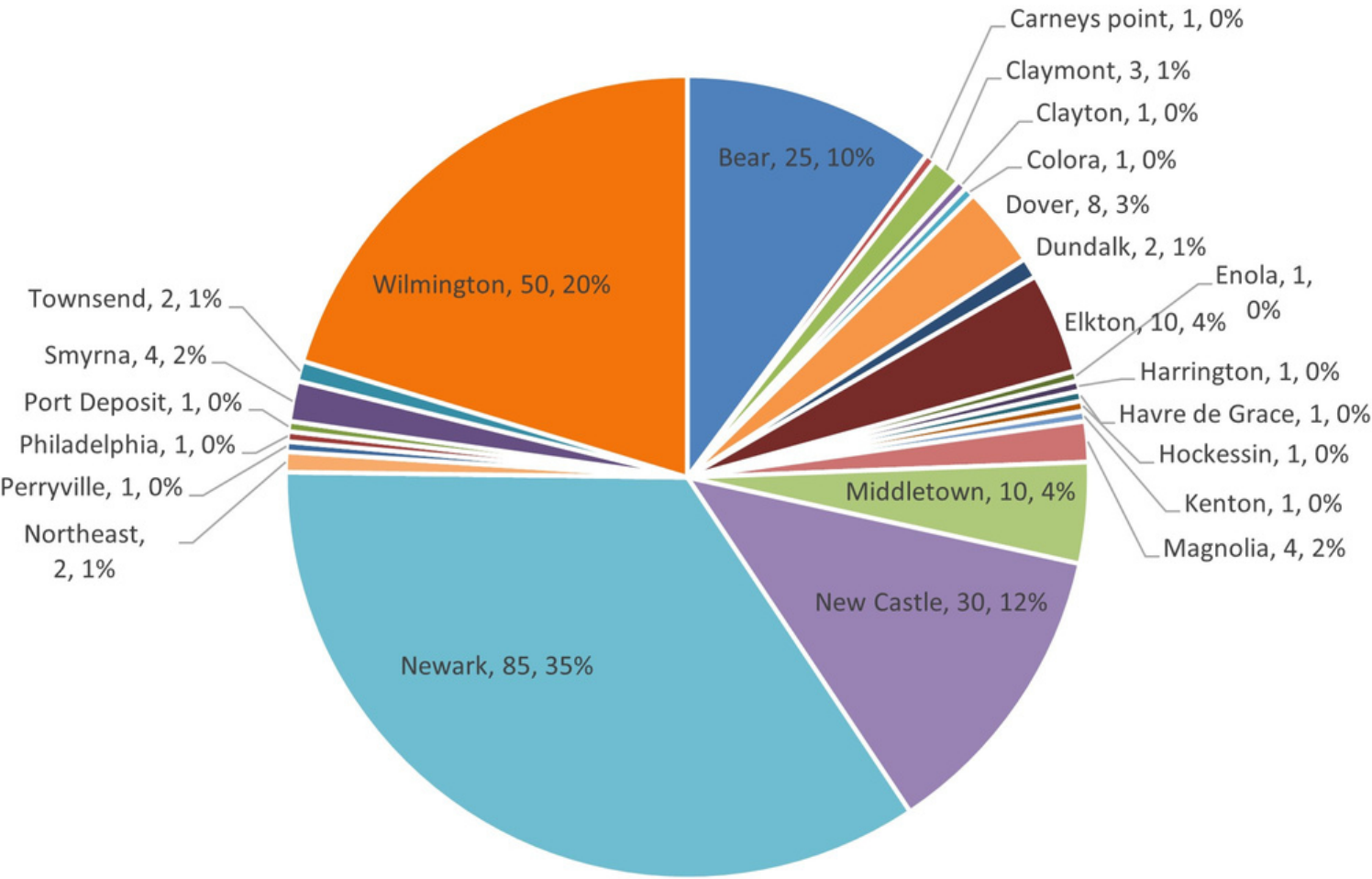
